**MOCA Systems awarded program and construction oversight contract for the \$650 million Fort Belvoir Community Hospital**

**Watertown, MA (October 5, 2007)** - MOCA Systems was awarded a \$3 million, 3-year indefinite delivery contract from the Army Corps of Engineers' Norfolk division to provide project control oversight for the design and construction of the \$649 million Fort Belvoir's new community hospital.

The \$650 million and 1.2 million square foot facility, designed to treat wounded soldiers and their families, is being built in conjunction with the Army's program for base realignment and closure (BRAC), which will shift nearly 19,000 workers to Fort Belvoir in Fairfax County. When the hospital is completed over the next three years by late 2010, the Army Medical Command will staff and operate it. The hospital will have 120 in-patient beds, a 10-bed intensive care unit, a 10-bed behavioral health inpatient unit, a cancer center and an emergency department.

Also included in the plans are a pharmacy, 10 operating rooms, diagnostic centers for pathology and radiology departments and a clinical space for outpatients. There is space for two parking garages that will have 2,600 spaces, a helipad, an ambulance shelter and a central energy plant.

The Arlington-based joint venture between Turner Construction and the regional office of Gilbane Building Co. have been awarded the construction contract. The Alexandria-based HDR and Fairfax-based Dewberry are designing the facility. The MOCA Systems oversight team includes Parsons Technology and Infrastructure and L-3 Communications as sub-contractor teaming partners.

Micheal Sullivan, MOCA's Program Manager, stated "we look forward to helping the Army Corps and the contractor teams complete this program on-time and within budget.
