MOCA Systems awarded program and construction oversight contract for the \$3 billion San Antonio MILCON and BRAC programs

Watertown, MA (June 27, 2007) - Parsons Technology and Infrastructure with teaming partner MOCA Systems have been awarded a \$50 million IDIQ contract from the Army Corps of Engineers' Fort Worth division to provide program management and design services for the \$2.7 billion San Antonio Military Construction (MILCON) and Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) program.

The overall San Antonio BRAC program needs to be completed by September 2011, and is comprised of multiple programs across Fort Sam Houston, Camp Bullis, Randolph AFB and Lackland AFB as well as the realignment of Brooks City-Base. The San Antonio Military Medical Center (SAMMC) will realign inpatient medical services from Wilford Hall Medical Center at Lackland AFB to Brooke Army Medical Center at Fort Sam Houston. This will provide medical care to over one million clinic visits per year, with complete care to military healthcare beneficiaries in the south central United States as well as specialized care to patients referred from all over the world.

The Medical Education and Training Campus (METC) will realign and consolidate the basic and specific medical officer training from all three military service branches across four separate military bases to a consolidated campus at Fort Sam Houston. Other significant efforts include the Center for Battlefield Health and Trauma (BHT) and the expansion of the Lackland AFB Basic Military Training (BMT).

MOCA Systems is a sub-contractor teaming partner to Parsons Technology and Infrastructure, and is responsible for the cost and schedule management of the San Antonio BRAC program over the four-year program.

"It has been a pleasure working with the Army Corps Fort Worth District BRAC Program Team, and we look forward to supporting the Army Corps and Parsons on this challenging program," stated Michael Carr, MOCA's Vice President.
