Chuck Thomsen Joins Board of Directors

Early in his career, he wrote some of the first programs to estimate construction cost and optimize return on investment in income-producing properties. He also developed some of the industry's first computer-based, interactive design programs. At 3D/I, Chuck created and led a full-time R&D group with two missions. Part of the group, normally a staff of 8, focused on the application of computer technology to design and construction. They developed many practical applications for program management information systems, project team collaboration and facility condition assessment that were applied to hundreds of 3D/I projects. Another part of the R&D group, typically a staff of 3 interns, interviewed construction program management groups in some of the country's largest institutions, corporations and government agencies to develop a comprehensive understanding of the best practices in program management.
