## **MOCA Awarded Contract to Oversee Major Hospital Projects by Health Facilities Planning Agency**

*MOCA and The Innova Group to serve as Subcontractors to VW International*

**NEWTON, Mass. – Oct. 30, 2011** – The U.S. Army’s Health Facilities Planning Agency (HFPA) has awarded MOCA Systems, Inc. (MOCA) a contract for Master Integrated Scheduling Support for its significant medical facility upgrades at Fort Hood and Fort Benning. MOCA will serve as a subcontractor to VW International, which specializes in military healthcare facility and logistics planning and management services.

Fort Hood is replacing its existing aging hospital with a \$708 million, 944,000 square foot facility that will provide comprehensive care services to the 55,000 soldiers and 150,000 family members and retirees in the Fort Hood area. Fort Benning is also replacing its 50-year-old hospital with a 745,000 square foot, \$350 million facility which will be built near the existing building to speed construction. The new facility will provide double the capacity of the old facility. Both projects are scheduled to be completed in 2014.

MOCA will collaborate with The Innova Group, which provides transition and equipment procurement services for healthcare facilities, to develop a Master Integrated Schedule (MIS) that will incorporate all of the project’s activities and establish milestones. The MIS will allow the HFPA and contractors to identify possible interruptions to project milestones so they can be quickly analyzed and mitigated to prevent project delays, which is integral to these projects, which require fast-paced delivery. It also helps all parties involved to understand how their actions will affect other participants as well as the overall project’s success. The model MOCA develops also will be applicable to HFPA’s future projects.
